Easy Drinking - Pale Ale / Kölsch / Amber / Brown

- Alaskan Amber** – Alaskan Brewing Co, Juneau, AK, 5% abv 12oz bottle
Alaska's answer to the classic German *Altbier* style. Mildly malty and copper.....5.00
- Butte Creek Organic Ale** – Butte Creek Brewing Co., Chico, CA, 5.4% abv 12oz bottle
This refreshing *Amber Ale* is made with certified organic hops and barley.4.50
- Downtown Brown** – Lost Coast Brewing, Eureka, CA, 5% abv 12oz bottle
Classic *Nut Brown Ale*. Easy drinker and a local favorite.....4.50
- Fat Tire Amber** – New Belgium Brewing Co., Fort Collins, CO, 5.3% abv 12oz bottle
This *Amber Ale's* appeal is in its feat of balance: Toasty malt flavors (sorta like biscuits just pulled from the oven) coasting in equilibrium with crisp hoppiness.4.50
- Flying Dog Tire Bite** – Flying Dog Brewery, Frederick, MD, 5% abv 12oz bottle
The first *Kölsch* to make our beer list, an ale yeast is used, but fermented at a cold, lager-like temperature. This is a very easy drinker, but with some real character.....4.50
- Sierra Nevada Pale Ale** – Sierra Nevada Brewing Company, Chico, CA, 5.6% abv 12oz bottle
This classic *Pale Ale* is a perfect balance of cascade hops and malt character..... 4.50
- St. Peter's Sorghum Beer** – St. Peter's, Bungay, England, 4.2% abv 500ml (~17oz) bottle
Finally, a GLUTEN-FREE beer worth drinking! Classic refreshing *Lager*, with a unique character provided by sorghum. Served in a special St. Peter's Glass.....8.50

Hoppy stuff! - India Pale Ale (IPA) / Rye

- Dogfish Head 90 Minute Imperial IPA** – Dogfish Head Brewery, Milton, DE, 9% abv 12oz bottle
Massively potent IPA from the east coast. So incredibly good that if you don't like it, you're wrong. Malty balance distinguishes this from the more ferociously bitter west coast style8.50
- Hop Rod Rye Ale** – Bear Republic Brewing Company, Healdsburg, CA 8% abv 22oz bottle
Hop Rod contains a grist of 20% rye malt, and IPA level hoppiness with a caramel finish. An excellent rye beer.....6.50
- Hop Stoopid** – Lagunitas Brewing Company, Petaluma, CA, 8% abv 22oz bottle
Let's face it. This is a big hop bomb shaped like a beer bottle. It's hoptastic.....8.00
- Lagunitas IPA** – Lagunitas Brewing Company, Petaluma, CA, 5.7% abv 12oz bottle
Well balanced hop character make this India pale ale an excellent example of the style.....4.50
- Racer 5 IPA** – Bear Republic Brewing Company, Healdsburg, CA 7% abv 12oz bottle
A very hoppy IPA, showcasing the personalities of Cascade and Columbus hops. Racer 5 has won a slew of medals, and is a personal favorite.....5.00
- Sierra Nevada Torpedo Ale** – Sierra Nevada Brewing Company, Chico, CA, 7.2% abv 12oz bottle
The eponymous torpedo-shaped hopback gives this dry IPA a distinct hoppy finish. A really good west-coast IPA..... 4.50

Super Smooth - English Ales, Stouts, and Porters

Flying Dog Road Dog Porter – Flying Dog Brewery, Frederick, MD, 6% abv 12oz bottle A Scottish-style porter, with significant maltiness, and medium body.....	4.50
Fullers ESB – Fullers, London, England, 5.9% abv 12oz bottle Rich and complex, this premium ESB is extremely smooth, and pours a beautiful mahogany. Bitter only in name, this is a malty beer, with little actual bitterness.....	4.50
Maui Coconut Porter – Maui Brewing Company, Maui, HI, 5.7% abv 12oz Chocolaty with a touch of coconut. Superb.....	6.00
Moylan's Kilt Lifter – Moylan's Brewery, Novato, CA, 8% abv 22oz bottle Rich malt notes and balanced hops in a huge traditional <i>Scottish Ale</i>	6.50
Murphy's Irish Stout – Magor, Caldicot, Gwent, Wales, 4.3% abv 14.9oz nitro can A classic dry Irish stout; easy to drink several, some chocolate and coffee notes.....	4.50
St. Ambroise Oatmeal Stout – McAuslan Brewing, Montreal, Canada, 5% 12oz bottle One of the world's most award-winning stouts; a great dry stout with some of the slippery mouthfeel of oats. Really, really, good.....	7.50
Tetley's English Ale – Leeds (Carlsberg UK), Leeds, England, 5% abv 14.9oz nitro can A great session beer, Tetley's is a very smooth ale with a creamy nitrogen head.....	4.50
Young's 2X Chocolate Stout – Wells & Youngs, Bedford, England, 5.2% abv 14.9oz nitro can That's real dark chocolate you're tasting. In stout. Need I say more?.....	6.00

Summery Beer – Wheats, Flavored Beers, Ciders

Abita Purple Haze – Abita Brewing Company, Covington, LA, 4.75% abv 12oz bottle Abita Brewing uses Raspberries make this fruit wheat beer a summer favorite.....	4.50
Ace Apple Cider – California Cider Company, Sebastopol, CA, 5% abv 12oz bottle Made locally from local apples. This cider has nice apple flavor, a touch tart.....	5.00
Ace Pear Cider – California Cider Company, Sebastopol, CA, 5% abv 12oz bottle Sweeter than the apple counterpart, refreshing.....	5.00
Erdinger Weissbier – Erdinger Weissbräu, Erding, Germany, 5.3% abv 12oz bottle This German Hefeweizen is brewed using traditional bottle-fermentation, never pasteurized.....	4.50
He'Brew Origin Pomegranate – Old Saratoga Brewing, Saratoga Springs, NY 8% abv 22oz bottle Exactly what I like in a fruit beer; medium hops, and just enough fruit to make you think about what it could be. Pomegranate, it turns out, is what it is. And it's good. Really good.....	8.00

Crisp and Refreshing – Lager / Pilsner / Blonde Ale / Steam Beer

Anchor Steam – Anchor Brewing Co., San Francisco, CA, 4.9% abv 12oz bottle
This California Common has an aroma of sweet malt, caramel, fruitiness and a bit of bitter/earthy hops. It's name is derived from the 19th century when "steam" seems to have been a nickname for beer brewed on the West Coast of America under primitive conditions and without ice.....4.50

Czech Rebel – Mestansky Pivovar, Havlíčkův Brod, Czech Republic, 4.7% abv 12oz bottle
This authentic bohemian pilsener has the crisp, somewhat grassy character which comes from the very soft brewing water used in the Czech Republic.....4.50

Eel River Organic Blonde Ale – Eel River Brewing Co., Fortuna, CA, 5.62% abv 12oz bottle
With an exceptionally crisp palate, this blonde ale balances its light malt palate with a subtle bitterness. It's an ideal beer for those unaccustomed to micro-brewed beers.....4.50

Hofbräu München – Taatliches Hofbräuhaus München, Munich, Germany, 4.9% abv 50cl bottle
This pale German lager is what a refreshing lager beer all about. Smooth, light, and crisp without sacrificing flavor.....5.00

Stiegl Gaudi-Radler Zitrone – Stiegl, Salzburg, Austria, 2.5% abv, 25cl bottle
50% Lager 50% Lemon Soda. Easy and refreshing.....5.00

The Vault – Specialty Beers / Belgians / Stronges / Sours / Barleywine

Affligem Blonde – Brouwerij Affligem, Opwijk, Belgium, 7%, 330ml bottle
A real abbey Blonde. Low on bitterness, easy blonde Belgian.....6.00

Bière de Mars – Jolly Pumpkin Artisan Ales, Dexter, MI, 7% abv 25oz bottle
Quite tart with caramel undertones. Hugely complex, with a flavor spectrum that changes as the beer warms. Unreal.....16.00

Dogfish Head Palo Santo Marron – Dogfish Head Brewery, Milton, DE, 12% abv 12oz bottle
Big American strong aged on palo santo wood from Paraguay. This beer is highly roasty, and malty brown ale aged on the wood of the Palo Santo tree from Paraguay. Palo Santo means "holy tree" and its wood has been used in South American wine-making communities.....8.50

Duvel – Brouwerij Moortgat, Breendonk-Puurs, Belgium, 8.5% abv 12oz bottle
Best in class Belgian strong ale. Dry, fragrant, masterful. Enjoy with respect for its potency.....7.50

Delirium Tremens – Brouwerij Huyghe, Melle, Belgium, 8.5% abv, 33cl bottle (~12oz)
One of the great Belgian Strong beers, this has honeysuckle and orange notes, is warming on the throat, and is served in the proper pink elephant tulip glass.....7.00

EKU 28 – Kulmbacher Brauerei, Kulmbach, Germany, 11% abv, 12oz bottle
Once the strongest beer available, this is a warming and malty, but never cloying Eisbock. A deserved reputation for standing in for fine Scotch, a truly remarkable beer.....6.00

Fullers 2008 Vintage Ale – Fullers, London, England, 8.5% abv 500ml bottle
I've put away a very few bottles of the retired 2008 Fuller's Vintage ale. Warming and complex,
this is a great beer to enjoy, or put away to age.....20.00

Girardin Gueuze Black Label, Brouwerij Girardin, Sint Ulriks-Kapelle, Belgium 5% abv 37.5cl bot
This flawless Gueuze defines the style. Very tart, dry, and remarkably complex.....10.00

Glazen Toren Canaster Winterscotch, Kleinbrouwerij De Glazen Toren, Erpe-Mere, Belgium, 9.5%
abv 750 ml (wine bottle)
One of the world's most remarkable breweries, the “Glass Towers” produces a very, very fine winter
warmer.....25.00

Grimbergen Dubbel – Brasserie Union, Jumet, Belgium, 6.5% abv, 330ml (~12oz) bottle
This Abbey Dubbel has toffee and scotch notes, and is somewhat dry.....6.00

Hair of the Dog Adam – Hair of the Dog Brewing, Portland, OR, 10% abv 12oz bottle
The good stuff. The only currently brewed example of Adambier, a long-lost style from Dortmund,
Germany. Tastes of currents, malt; hugely complex. Masterful beer.....8.00

Oaked Arrogant Bastard – Stone Brewing Company, Escondido, CA, 7.2% abv 12oz bottle
An American strong ale, this is Stone's Arrogant Bastard, made better by aging on oak chips.....7.00

Pugsley's Signature Barleywine – Shipyard Brewing Company, Portland, ME , 8.5% abv, 22oz bottle
An excellent American barleywine, from Shipyard's brewmaster Alan Pugsley. Dominated by malt
character with great hop aroma..... 9.50

St. Louis Kriek – Brouwerij Vanhonsbrouck, Ingelmunster, Belgium, 4.5% abv 12.7oz bottle
A Cherry fruit lambic. Balanced cherry, fairly sweet; champagne-like.....10.00
