Draft Beer

- NEW Sierra Nevada Celebration** – Sierra Nevada Brewery, Chico CA, 6.8% abv
Generous portions of barley malts and fine whole hops of several varieties, creating a brew with a full, rich and hearty character.5.00
- NEW Youngs 2x Chocolate Stout** – Wells & Youngs, Bedford, England, 5.2% abv
Real chocolate separates this *stout* from the pack. Never overly sweet, but indulgent nonetheless..4.50
- Guinness Draught** – St. Jame's Gate, Dublin, Ireland , 4.1% abv
Initial malt and caramel flavor, this *dry stout* finishes with a dry roasted bitterness.....4.00
- Death & Taxes** – Moonlight Brewery, Santa Rosa, CA, 5.0% abv
A very dark, yet surprisingly light-bodied *lager*, crisp and refreshing.3.75
- Sierra Nevada Harvest** – Sierra Nevada Brewery, Chico CA, 6.7 % abv
Next in Sierra's Harvest line of seasonal beers, this brew contains only fresh hops from Yakima, WA, picked in a single day, and brewed the following. Look for pine and citrus notes.....4.00
- Sonoma Farmhouse Ale** – Lagunitas Brewing Co., Petaluma, CA, 5.2% abv
A Traditionally Brewed French Country Style *Ale* With A Twist.....4.00
- Chimay Cinq Cents** – Chimay, Baileux, Belgium, 8% abv
This *Abbey Tripple* is characterized by its aroma which results from an agreeable combination of fresh hops and yeast.....9.50
- Pliny the Elder** – Russian River Brewing, Santa Rosa, CA, 8% abv
Named for the Roman scholar who introduced the botanical name for hops (*lupus Salictarius*, or *wolf among the scrubs*), this imperial IPA is big, hoppy, and delicious.....4.50
- Mothership Wit** – New Belgium Brewing Co., Fort Collins , CO, 4.8% abv
New Belgium's *Wit bier* (white beer) is a traditional wheat beer style incorporating organic barley, and hints of orange peel and coriander.....3.75
- Ace Joker Cider** – California Cider Co., Sebastopol, CA, **9% abv**
A *dry cider* with champagne-like body. Fragrant apple and sharp notes dominate.....4.50

Bottles

Easy drinking - Pale Ale / Kölsch / Amber / Brown

- NEW Moylan's Irish Red** – Moylan's Brewery, Novato, CA, 6.5% abv **22oz** bottle
This *Irish ale* is a modern classic; malty and gently hopped, and a gorgeous red color.....6.50
- Butte Creek Organic Ale – Butte Creek Brewing Co., Chico, CA, 5.4% abv 12oz bottle
This refreshing *amber ale* is made with certified organic hops and barley.3.75
- Fat Tire Amber – New Belgium Brewing Co., Fort Collins , CO, 5.3% abv 12oz bottle
This Amber Ale's appeal is in its feat of balance: Toasty malt flavors (sorta like biscuits just pulled from the oven) coasting in equilibrium with crisp hoppiness.3.50
- Flying Dog Tire Bite – Flying Dog Brewery, Frederick, MD, 5% abv 12oz bottle
The first *Kölsch* to make our beer list, an ale yeast is used, but fermented at a cold, lager-like temperature. This is a very easy drinker, but with some real character.....4.00
- Sierra Nevada Pale Ale – Sierra Nevada Brewing Company, Chico, CA, 5.6% abv 12oz bottle
This classic *pale ale* is a perfect balance of cascade hops and malt character..... 3.50
- Wolaver's Brown – Otter Creek Brewing, Middlebury, VT, 5.7% abv 12oz bottle
Copper beer with nice caramel and brown sugar qualities. Yummy and balanced.....3.50

Hoppy stuff! - India Pale Ale (IPA) / Rye

- Lagunitas IPA – Lagunitas Brewing Company, Petaluma, CA, 5.7% abv 12oz bottle
Well balanced hop character make this *India pale ale* an excellent example of the style.....3.50
- Leafer Madness Imperial IPA – Beer Valley Brewing Co., Ontario, OR, **9% abv 22oz bottle**
A heady, hoppy beer; strong and great for sharing. Some residual sweetness.....12.50
- Hop Rod Rye Ale – Bear Republic Brewing Company, Healdsburg, CA **8% abv 22oz bottle**
Hop Rod contains a grist of 20% rye malt, and IPA level hoppiness with a caramel finish. An excellent *rye beer*.....6.00
- Racer 5 IPA – Bear Republic Brewing Company, Healdsburg, CA 7% abv 12oz bottle
A very hoppy *IPA*, showcasing the personalities of Cascade and Columbus hops. Racer 5 has won a slew of medals, and is a personal favorite.....3.50

Super smooth - English Ales, Stouts, and Porters

- NEW St. Peter's Old-Style Porter** – St. Peter's, Bungay, England, 5.1% abv 500ml (~17oz) bottle
This fine beer is a blend of a mature old ale with a younger light beer - just as a true Porter should be. Dark in colour and complex in taste. Served in a special St. Peter's Glass.....8.50
- NEW Lagunitas Cappuccino Stout** – Lagunitas Brewing, Petaluma, CA, **8.3% abv 22oz bottle**
Lagunitas' original stout, brewed with real Hardcore Coffee from Sebastopol.....6.50

Fullers ESB – Fullers, London, England, 5.9% abv 12oz bottle
Rich and complex, this premium *ESB* is extremely smooth, and pours a beautiful mahogany.
Bitter only in name, this is a malty beer, with little actual bitterness.....4.00

VERY limited quantities! Maui Coconut Porter – Maui Brewing Company, Maui, HI, 5.7% abv 12oz
Chocolaty with a touch of coconut. Superb.....6.00

Tetley's English Ale – Leeds (Carlsberg UK), Leeds, England, 5% abv 14.9oz nitro can
A great session beer, Tetley's is a very smooth ale with a creamy nitrogen head.....4.00

Summery beer – Wheats, Flavored beers, Ciders

NEW Erdinger Oktoberfest Weizen – Erdinger Weissbräu, Erding, Germany, 5.7% abv 12oz bottle
This *German Hefeweizen* is brewed using traditional bottle-fermentation, never pasteurized.....4.00

Abita Purple Haze – Abita Brewing Company, Covington, LA, 4.75% abv 12oz bottle
Abita Brewing uses Raspberries make this *fruit wheat beer* a summer favorite.....3.75

Ace Apple Cider – California Cider Company, Sebastopol, CA, 5% abv 12oz bottle
Made locally from local apples. This *cider* has nice apple flavor, a touch tart.....4.50

Ace Pear Cider – California Cider Company, Sebastopol, CA, 5% abv 12oz bottle
Sweeter than the apple counterpart, refreshing.....4.50

He'Brew Origin Pomegranate – Old Saratoga Brewing, Saratoga Springs, NY **8% abv 22oz** bottle
Exactly what I like in a fruit beer; medium hops, and just enough fruit to make you think about
what it could be. Pomegranate, it turns out, is what it is. And it's good. Really good.....8.00

Crisp and refreshing – Lager / Pilsner / Blonde ale / Steam Beer

Hofbräu München – Taatliches Hofbräuhaus München, Munich, Germany, 4.9% abv 12oz bottle
This *pale German lager* is what a refreshing lager beer all about. Smooth, light, and crisp
without sacrificing flavor.....4.50

Anchor Steam – Anchor Brewing Co., San Francisco, CA, 4.9% abv 12oz bottle
This *California Common* has an aroma of sweet malt, caramel, fruitiness and a bit of bitter/earthy
hops. It's name is derived from the 19th century when "steam" seems to have been a nickname for
beer brewed on the West Coast of America under primitive conditions and without ice.....3.50

Eel River Organic Blonde Ale – Eel River Brewing Co., Fortuna , CA, 5.62% abv 12oz bottle
With an exceptionally crisp palate, this *blonde ale* balances it's light malt palate with a subtle
bitterness. It's an ideal beer for those unaccustomed to micro-brewed beers.....3.75

Starobrno Lager – Starobrno Brewery, Brno, Czech Republic, 5.0% abv 12oz bottle
This authentic *bohemian pilsener* has the crisp, somewhat grassy character which comes from
the very soft brewing water used in the Czech Republic.....3.50

The Vault – Specialty beers / Belgians / Strongs / Barleywine

- NEW Dogfish Head Palo Santo Marron** – Dogfish Head Brewery, Milton, DE, **12% abv** 12oz bottle
Big *American strong* aged on palo santo wood from Paraguay. This beer is highly roasty, and malty brown ale aged on the wood of the Palo Santo tree from Paraguay. Palo Santo means "holy tree" and its wood has been used in South American wine-making communities.....8.50
- Calabaza Blanca – Jolly Pumpkin Artisan Ales, Dexter, MI, 4.8% abv 25oz bottle
Authentic *bier blanche*, sharp and acidic, refreshing, VERY complex. A new favorite of your humble brewmaster.....15.75
- St. Louis Pêche – Brouwerij Vanhonnebrouck, Ingelmunster, Belgium, 3.5% abv 12.7oz bottle
A peach *fruit lambic*. Balanced peachy, fairly sweet; champagne-like.....10.00
- Duvel – Brouwerij Moortgat, Breendonk-Puurs, Belgium, **8.5% abv** 12oz bottle
Best in class *Belgian strong* ale. Dry, fragrant, masterful. Enjoy with respect for its potency.....7.00
- Delirium Tremens – Brouwerij Huyghe, Melle, Belgium, **8.5% abv**, 33cl bottle (~12oz)
One of the great *Belgian Strong* beers, this has honeysuckle and orange notes, is warming on the throat, and is served in the proper pink elephant tulip glass.....7.00
- Oaked Arrogant Bastard – Stone Brewing Company, Escondido, CA, 7.2% abv 12oz bottle
An *American strong* ale, this is Stone's Arrogant Bastard, made better by aging on oak chips.....7.00
- Girardin Gueuze Black Label, Brouwerij Girardin, Sint Ulriks-Kapelle, Belgium 5% abv 37.5cl bot
This flawless *Gueuze* defines the style. Very tart, dry, and remarkably complex.....10.00
- Glazen Toren Saison dErpe-Mere, Kleinbrouwerij De Glazen Toren, Erpe-Mere, Belgium, 7.5% abv **750 ml (wine bottle)**
One of the world's great *Saison's*, Glazen Toren is hazy, citrusy, and floral.....25.00
- Green Flash Barleywine – Green Flash Brewing Company, Vista, CA, **10% abv, 22oz** bottle
An excellent *American barleywine*, dominated by malt character with great hop aroma..... 12.00
- Grimbergen Dubbel -- Brasserie Union, Jumet, Belgium, 6.5% abv, 330ml (~12oz) bottle
This *Abbey Dubbel* has toffee and scotch notes, and is somewhat dry.....5.00

Wine

You may think that grapes are just for making grape beer, but it turns out that some people like drinking wine too. Generous ¼ bottle by-the-glass house wine pours.

Bohème Chardonnay, Taylor Ridge, Occidental, California

This subdued oaky chard is as local as can be, and our best selling wine..... 9.50gl/35.00

NEW Bohème Pinot Noir, Taylor Ridge, Occidental, California

Bright cherry and caramel – the palate is sophisticated and elegant with a very long finish. Local and extraordinary.....11.50gl/42.00

Smoking Loon Cabernet Sauvignon, California

Our house Cab. Plum and cherry flavors carry over nicely to the palate, where the flavors are intense and well proportioned..... 6.50gl/18.00

Smoking Loon Pinot Noir, California

Our house Pinot. Fruit forward and wonderfully drinkable, the 'Loon pinot pairs nicely with just about everything..... 6.50gl/18.00

Smoking Loon Chardonnay, California

Our house Chard. Fresh, pleasing aromas of bright fruit, balanced acidity, and light vanilla oak notes..... 6.50gl/18.00

Dry Creek Vinyard Fumé Blanc, (Sauvignon Blanc), Sonoma County, California

Bright, crisp varietal character and mineral undertones and inviting aromas of fresh grass, lemon, and grapefruit lead to juicy flavors of citrus, lime, and crushed stone nuances.....15.00 half bottle (375ml)

Frei Bros. Redwood Creek Cabernet, California

Mild on the palate, the cozy Redwood Creek Cabernet delivers pleasing red fruit flavors that simply slide onto the palate; try with burgers.....15.00

Gnarly Head Old Vine Zinfandel '06, Lodi, California

The rich Gnarly Head Zinfandel brings you right into the beautiful land of old vine zin vine..... 25.00

Cycles Gladiator Pinot Noir, California

This is pure Pinot Noir with a hint of spiciness on the nose. Wild berry and vanilla notes..... 28.00

Trinity Oaks Chardonnay '06, California

Fine ripeness and impressive balance; finishes easily..... 15.00
